



4 REPORT OF THE ECPGR STEERING COMMITTEE: TWELFTH MEETING

Long-term goal

National, Sub-regional and Regional Programmes in Europe rationally and effectively conserve *ex situ* and *in situ* PGRFA and increase their utilization.

Outcomes

- AEGIS is operational and accessions in AEGIS are characterized and evaluated.
- 2. The functionality of EURISCO meets users' expectations, and the quantity and quality of its data are enhanced, including *in situ* and on-farm data.
- 3. In situ and on-farm conservation and management concepts are agreed.
- Commitment and regular resources of national governments are sustained or increased; commitments and resources to ECPGR from the European Commission and other potential donors are increased.
- Relations with users of germplasm are strengthened.
- Organizational structure and secretarial support are adequate to effectively sustain ECPGR's operations.
