Outcome of evaluation by the ExCo

Evaluation based on 4 criteria:

- 1. Effectiveness with ECPGR Outcomes (50%)
- 2. Applicability of results to the entire European Region (20%)
- 3. Cost effectivenmess of activity (20)%
- 4. Appropriateness, quality and diversity of partnership (10%)

Scale: 1= none or very low ,2= low, 3= medium, 4= high, 5= very high

Most common aspects requiring amendment

Presentation of projects:

- formal aspects;
- scientifically sound basis of work
- respect requirements of «Background», «Justification» and «Methodology» as specified in the Template of application

Budget:

 ECPGR «philosophy»: main portion of budget should be reserved for meetings and less to activities (+ 75:25%)

Partnership:

- eligibility of partners; if not eligible, participation can be self-funded
- choice of funded participants: in case of more participants from the same country: not more than one from the same institution
- keep other WG members informed on ongoing project work
- regional representativeness
- seek links with other WGs and/or stakeholder groups

Countries that have not yet signed the Letter of Agreement for Phase IX

Countries that have not yet payed their membership fee Funding of participants only if membership fees payed Otherwise participation only on self-funded basis






Working Groups involved in Activities (1st, 2nd and 3 Calls)






Use of country quota during Phase IX (after 3 Calls)
