 - I'm glad that we will be able to continue to host ECPGR for its next phase
- Eva Thörn (ECPGR ExCo Chair):
 - I am very pleased that we could agree on a continued hosting of the ECPGR Secretariat at Bioversity for the next phase 2019 -2023 under the same conditions as during the current phase (of course with an adjusted overhead in the budget) – actually with reduced overheads, from 18.15% down to 15.84%
 - Continue to run EURISCO under the Bioversity legal framework and the same contract terms
 - Budget preparation for the next phase should be initiated in collaboration with Bioversity Finance and as usual be approved by you or your deputy
