Grant Scheme calls for proposals and requests for meetings (1/2)

- 11 proposals submitted (3,5 years)
 - 9 projects accepted (3 submitted twice)
 - 2 projects rejected
 - €188,155 awarded (compared to > €600,000 available for activities and meetings in Phase X)
- 2 requests accepted for meetings
 - Meetings delayed or cancelled/COVID-19

- ➤ Low number of submitted proposals → WG motivation?
- > Heterogeneous quality of proposals



Grant Scheme calls for proposals and requests for meetings (2/2)

- Changes operated by ExCo during Phase X to encourage the submission of more proposals
 - Increase in the number of calls (5/2019–2021)
 - Increase in the budget allocated to WGs
 - 10% of the budget for Activity Coordinator
- Change operated by ExCo to better specify its expectations:
 - Revision of criteria for rating (2020 and 2021)
- ➤ Better **define priorities** on PGR Strategy objectives and approaches with increase of ECPGR funds?
- ➤ Better link to and complement (?) other funded projects that could significantly contribute to prioritized objectives of the PGR Strategy



Contribution to the GenRes Bridge project

Plant advisory role in the elaboration process of the overarching **Genetic Resources Strategy for Europe**

- Secretariat, ExCo Chair and German NC
- Trans-domain task force "finalization of the Strategy" → ensuring consistency with plant strategy vision and actions

Active role in the elaboration process of Plant Genetic Resources Strategy for Europe

- Mobilization of a drafting team: 10 NC including ExCo members
- Compilation and synthesis of all contributions and feedback from SC members, WGs and other partners
- Finalization of an ambitious document for ECPGR and its members with a 10-year vision



GenRes Bridge: Complementary actions involving part of the Drafting Team

- Contribution to the preparation of the PGR Strategy presentation in Brussels and webinars
- Contribution to the production of a **Policy brief**: "PGR Conservation and Sustainable use: What should Europe urgently do?"
- Contribution to follow-up and lobby vis-à-vis policymakers (EU and national countries) to improve political awareness of GR in Europe
 - Started under EU French Presidency
 - To be continued under EU Czech Republic and Sweden Presidency
 - The importance of all ECPGR members to actively and continuously lobby their national policymakers and institutions concerning GR within and outside EU



Interactions with Working Groups

Appointment of WG Chairs:

- Fibre Crops (2019), Wheat (June 2020), Vitis (March 2022)
- Documentation and Information after revision of Chair's ToRs (Nov 2021)

Organization of a virtual meeting with WG Chairs:

- Opportunity to exchange with ExCo on WG activities and interactions
- Discussion on potential change in modus operandi of WGs for the next Phase XI
- ➤ The need to better specify role and modus operandi of WGs in the implementation of Phase XI



Communication strategy issues

- Finalization of the ECPGR Communication and Public Relations Strategy
- Involvement in the elaboration of a video on ECPGR.
 - TF chaired by ExCo Chair and including 3 NCs, L. Maggioni and E. Hermanowicz → (primary audience, type of video and associated narrative, duration, etc.).
 - Release in March 2021 with 1,000 views during the 1st year
- Contribution to the terms of reference to hire a new Editing and Communications Specialist (2021)



Interactions with Steering Committee members

GenRes Bridge:

- Feedback on strategies' intermediate and final documents (2020-2021)
- Webinar to present the PGR Strategy (2022)

Working Groups

- Search for and appointment of new WG Chairs
- Creation of a new cryopreservation WG → to be consolidated during Mid-Term SC



Interactions with Steering Committee members

- Finalization of ECPGR Communication Strategy "Vision and Mission"
- Finalization and adoption of the MoU for enhanced cooperation with the Crop Trust
- Finalization and adoption of an ECPGR position statement on Farmer's Pride project and results
- Preparation of the agenda of the Mid-Term SC meeting
- Formal agreement on proposals for appointments of new WG chairs and ExCo members



A few more messages...

- The WGs are an active component in ECPGR modus operandi
 - Need to review their role, composition and ways to contribute to the priorities of the PGR Strategy for Europe
 - Importance of regular interactions with ExCo (and SC?) on behalf of SC
- The ExCo is a supportive and flexible component in the ECPGR modus operandi
- However, the complementary work of Task Forces is essential to progress on specific issues and should be more visible in modus operandi



A few more messages...

The implementation of the PGR Strategy for Europe is a new challenge for ECPGR that needs:

- To define priorities within its current budget, possibly complemented by voluntary contributions
- To mobilize WGs and other internal and external bodies and institutions
 that could help in the implementation of prioritized actions
- To target 'part of/all' its funding to support these priorities
- To search for additional targeted money
- To continue active lobby of EU and national policymakers to ensure its full implementation in the next decade
